

Guidelines for Submitting an Intent to Build a Title Plant

PURPOSE

lowa Title Guaranty (ITG) recognizes that the 40-year title plant is the preferred method of providing title evidence for the purpose of issuing commitments and certificates. Unless the abstractor is exempt from the title plant requirement by virtue of a title plant waiver¹ or grandfathered status², participating abstractors must own or lease, and maintain and use in the preparation of abstracts, an up-to-date abstract title plant including tract indices for each county in which abstracts are prepared.³ The tract indices shall contain a reference to all instruments affecting the real estate which are recorded in the office of the county recorder, and shall commence not less than forty years prior to the date the abstractor commences participation in the lowa Title Guaranty program.⁴

POLICY

The Iowa Administrative Code provides that Iowa Title Guaranty may authorize an abstractor that is building or that intends to build a title plant within three years, provided the abstractor submits the following information to Iowa Title Guaranty for consideration:

- (1) The abstractor's business plan;
- (2) Evidence that a title plant will be built for a specific county or counties within three years;
- (3) A timeline for completion of the title plant; and
- (4) A description of the applicant's abstracting experience.⁵

Submissions must also include appropriate contact information, including but not limited to, abstract company name, primary contact name, business address, telephone, and email.
