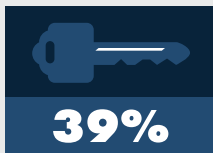

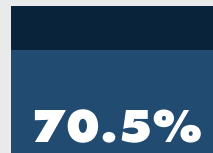
A HOUSEHOLD IS HOUSING **COST BURDENED**
