The Certificate of Training shall be current at the time that the IRS Form 8609 Application is submitted.

Mental Health First Aid is offered in the form of an interactive course that presents an overview of mental illness and substance use disorders in the United States and introduces participants to risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems, builds understanding of their impact, and overviews common treatments.
