CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Iowa Agricultural Development Division (IADD) Board of Directors was called to order by Chair Leonard on September 27, 2023 at 9:32 a.m. A quorum was established with the following Board Members present; Leonard, Townsley, Boyle, and McLain.

REVIEW OF MINUTES OF AUGUST 23, 2023 BOARD MEETING

Mr. Leonard presented the minutes of the August 23, 2023 IADD Board Meeting. Mr. Leonard asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes.

MOTION

On a motion by Mr. Boyle and a second by Mrs. McLain, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the August 23, 2023 IADD Board meeting.

REVIEW OF AUGUST 2023 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Becky Wu presented the August 2023 financials. She stated that for FY24 year-to-date, IADD had operating income of \$105,000, an operating expense of \$57,000, and a net operating income of \$48,000.

MOTION

On a motion by Mr. Boyle and a second by Mrs. Townsley, the Board unanimously approved the August 2023 financial statement as presented.

BEGINNING FARMER LOAN APPLICATIONS

Tammy Nebola introduced the following applications for Beginning Farmer loans:

<u>AG 23-042</u> – Mark R. and Shantel K. Lensing – Beginning farmer loan of \$222,320 to purchase approximately 40 acres of agricultural land in Winneshiek County. The loan will have a 4.70% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be equal to New York Prime; Rate floor 4.00%. The lender is Luana Savings Bank in Ossian, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-043</u> – Nathan J. Lensing – Beginning farmer loan of \$222,320 to purchase approximately 40 acres of agricultural land in Winneshiek County. The loan will have a 4.70% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be equal to New York Prime; Rate floor 4.00%. The lender is Luana Savings Bank in Ossian, lowa.

<u>AG 23-044</u> – Garret Lee and Regan E. Lensing – Beginning farmer loan of \$222,320 to purchase approximately 40 acres of agricultural land in Winneshiek County. The loan will have a 4.70% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be equal to New York Prime; Rate floor 4.00%. The lender is Luana Savings Bank in Ossian, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-047</u> – Clay R. Schurtz – Beginning farmer loan of \$281,250 to purchase approximately 40 acres of agricultural land in Cerro Gordo County. The loan will have a 5.38% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 75% of the 5 Year CMT plus a margin of 2.75%. The lender is First Citizens Bank in Mason City, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-048</u> – Kalen R. and Heidi A. Parker – Beginning farmer loan of \$156,500 to purchase approximately 10 acres of agricultural land, house and outbuildings in Cerro Gordo County. The loan will have a 5.15% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 75% of the 5 Year CMT plus a margin of 2.75%. The lender is First Citizens Bank in Mason City, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-049-I</u> – Howard S. and Mindi J. Noel – Beginning farmer contract sale of \$497,120 to purchase approximately 65.89 acres of agricultural land in Jasper County. The contract will have a 6.00% fixed interest rate and a contract length of 25 years. The contract seller is Dean Lane in Newton, lowa.

<u>AG 23-050</u> – Michael and Kaitlyn Bachtle – Beginning farmer loan of \$485,000 to purchase approximately 68.13 acres of agricultural land in Mitchell County. The loan will have a 4.70% fixed interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The lender is \$t. Ansgar State Bank in \$t. Ansgar, lowa.

AG 23-051 – Tyler J. Banowetz – Beginning farmer loan of \$616,100 to purchase approximately 134 acres of agricultural land and out-buildings in Jackson County. The loan will have a 6.00% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will

be 80% of First Trust & Savings Bank's base real estate interest rate. The lender is First Trust & Savings Bank in Grand Mound, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-052</u> – Nicholas Sandburg – Beginning farmer loan of \$231,000 to purchase approximately 36.89 acres of agricultural land in Muscatine County. The loan will have a 5.52% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 80% of the 5 year Treasury plus 3.00%. The lender is Hills Bank & Trust Company in Kalona, lowa.

<u>AG 23-053</u> – Gabriel and Kate Lorack – Beginning farmer loan of \$616,100 to purchase approximately 53.96 acres of agricultural land, house, out-buildings including a 41,000 Hd layer barn in Muscatine County. The loan will have a 5.27% variable interest rate and a loan length of 20 years. The index will be 80% of the 5 year Treasury plus 3.00%. The lender is Hills Bank & Trust Company in Kalona, lowa.

<u>AG 23-054</u> – Travis H. Dermody – Beginning farmer loan of \$477,500 to purchase approximately 199 acres of agricultural land in lowa County. The loan will have a 5.52% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 80% of the 5 year Treasury plus 3.00%. The lender is Hills Bank & Trust Company in Kalona, lowa.

AG 23-055 – Brock T. and Paige Caves – Beginning farmer loan of \$345,000 to purchase approximately 102 acres of agricultural land in Van Buren County. The loan will have a 5.20% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 80% of Pilot Grove Savings Bank Lending rate. The lender is Pilot Grove Savings Bank in Pilot Grove, lowa.

<u>AG 23-056</u> – Kaleb Salge – Beginning farmer loan of \$265,000 to purchase approximately 40 acres of agricultural land in Butler County. The loan will have a 5.25% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be 1.875% over the Des Moines FHLB. The lender is Lincoln Savings Bank in Reinbeck, Iowa.

<u>AG 23-057</u> – Braden Wayne Landt – Beginning farmer loan of \$498,000 to purchase approximately 77.84 acres of agricultural land and house in Clayton County. The loan will have a 4.95% variable interest rate and a loan length of 30 years. The index will be equal to Wall Street Prime. The lender is Luana Savings Bank in Luana, lowa.

MOTION

On a motion by Mrs. Townsley and a second by Mrs. McLain, the Board unanimously approved the BFLP applications.

PUBLIC HEARING ON BEGINNING FARMER LOANS

A public hearing was held by the IADD Board at the Iowa Finance Authority office on September 27, 2023 at 10:16 a.m. There were no comments received regarding the Beginning Farmer Loan applications. The public hearing was closed at 10:17 a.m.

MOTION

On a motion by Mrs. McLain and a second by Mrs. Townsley, the Board unanimously recommended approval of the BFLP Bond documents.

BEGINNING FARMER TAX CREDIT APPLICATIONS

Nicki Howell presented a summary of the Beginning Farmer Tax Credit applications. There were 23 new BFTC applications for an estimated tax credit amount of \$390,269. She noted that of those 23; 15 are cash rent, 7 are crop share, and one is a flex lease.

MOTION

On a motion by Mr. Boyle and a second by Mrs. Townsley, the Board unanimously recommended approval of the Beginning Farmer Tax Credit applications as presented.

MARKETING UPDATE

Included in the Board packet is the IADD marketing calendar. Tammy Nebola and Mr. Leonard gave a brief review of the NARRC Conference, which they and Nicki Howell attended September 17-20th in Wichita, Kansas. She also discussed some upcoming events. Tammy, Nicki, and Mr. Boyle will be attending the NCOSAFP Conference in Raleigh, NC on October 1-4th. Staff will be presenting at Iowa State University in November and at a Young Farmer Workshop in Atlantic in December.

IFA BOARD MEETING UPDATE

Mr. Leonard presented the agenda from the September 6, 2023 IFA Board Meeting. Aaron Smith gave a brief overview of the meeting, which was held in Cedar Rapids and the Housinglowa Conference.
