Registration Available for ILTA CLTP Courses

Registration is available online for the four professional development courses in the Iowa Land Title Association (ILTA) Certified Land Title Professional (CLTP) Program.

There are two opportunities to register for the courses, except Legal Descriptions is only available at the UNI location. Each registration is identified by the location, as either the University of Northern Iowa (UNI) in Cedar Falls or Iowa Finance Authority (IFA) in Des Moines.

Each location has enacted safety measures for course instructors and registrants. Information is available on the general information page of the registration online.

Live instruction is provided at UNI and transmitted via Zoom to the Des Moines location. Persons attending the courses at both locations will have an opportunity to provide questions and receive responses to those questions from the instructors at UNI, and to participate in the exams*.

UNI & IFA Locations. Registration closes May 21.

UNI Only Location. Registration closes August 20.

November 12: Legal Entities/Special Circumstances

UNI & IFA Locations. Registration closes October 22.
